Notice of Intent to Reopen for In-Person Instruction

October 21, 2020

Pursuant to the Blueprint for a Safer Economy issued by the Governor's office on August 28, 2020, and other applicable authority, schools within a county are permitted to reopen for in-person instruction 14 days after the state transitions the county from Tier 1 to Tier 2.

On behalf of Linns Valley-Poso Flat Union School District, this document shall serve as official notice of Linns Valley-Poso Flat Union School District's intention to begin the process of reopening its public school to all students on October 28, 2020. The district will implement the reopening of its schools pursuant to its Reopening Schools Plan prepared by Linns Valley-Poso Flat Union School District in consultation with current health and safety guidance from the California Department of Public Health. Students in grades TK-6th returned to in-person learning on October 5, 2020 under a waiver and all other students will return on October 28, 2020. The current updated Reopening School Plan has been posted to our website at linnsvalleyschooldistrict.org.
